



You can be a good ally by engaging with some basic privacy and information security activism.

Use secure messaging tools like Signal. This helps to normalize people exercising their right to keep their messages private.

Use a password manager like lastpass, and enable two-factor authentication on your accounts where possible.
This makes it much harder to access your information,
which helps to protect you and your friends from information leaks and doxxing.
